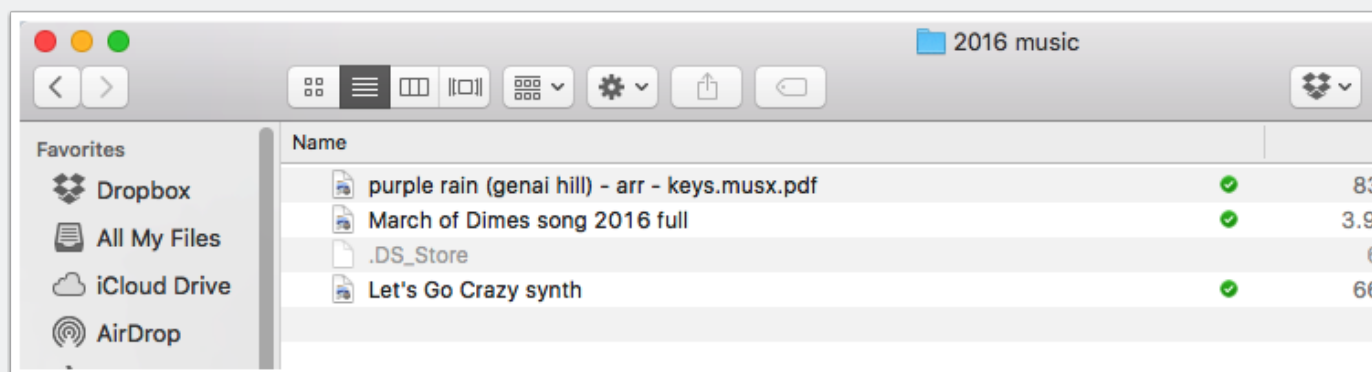


How to download all files in a folder from Dropbox.com

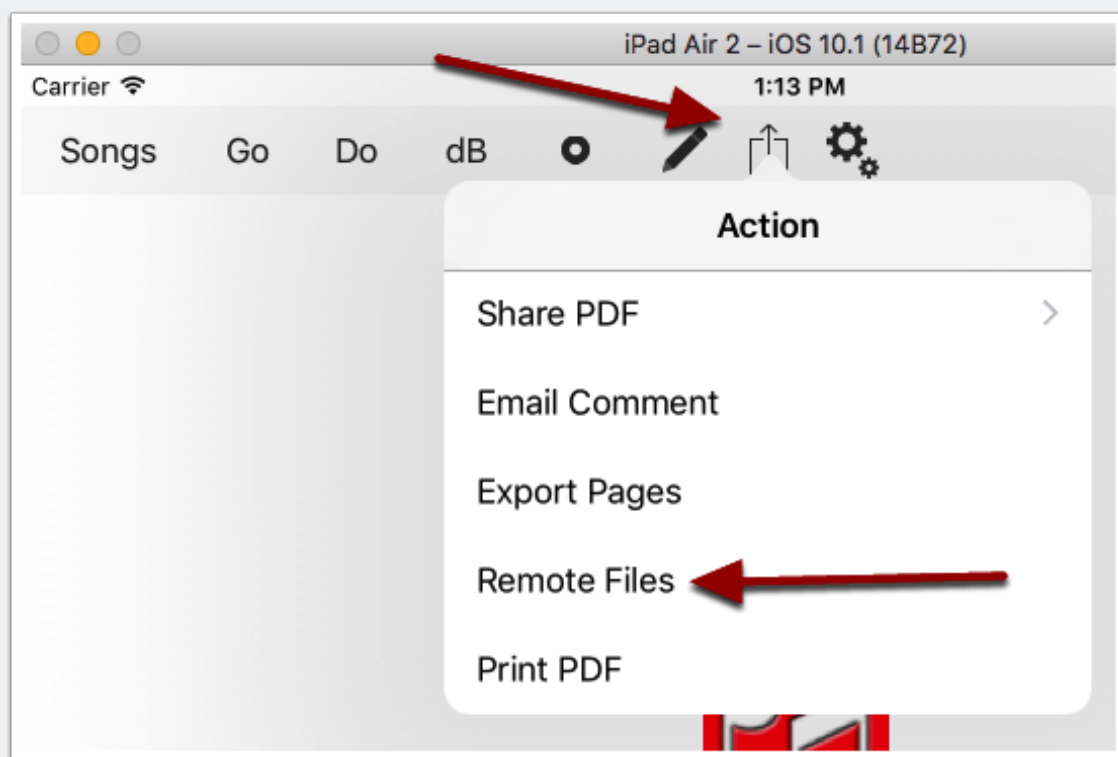
First, create a dropbox account and put PDF files into a folder. In this case, the folder is called 2016 music.

Run unrealBook and go to the action->Remote Files window


Choose Remote Files

Sign into Dropbox if needed.

Enter your email address and password if prompted.
